Ken Bailey Video Class — June 5th and 10th

This series on "Jesus Interprets His Own Cross" continues the "Dramatic Actions of Jesus," focusing on the words and actions of Jesus which were not precisely understood. Dr. Bailey cites four more examples of such dramatic actions in Jesus' ministry. They include the lack of hospitality by Simon the Pharisee, healings by Jesus on the Sabbath, His healing of the paralytic by the pool, and His confrontation with the people seeking to stone the woman taken in adultery. Identical one-hour sessions will be held in Founders' Hall on Wednesday the 5th at 7pm and Monday the 10th at 2pm, each followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. You are invited to attend one of these classes. Please note that from now on the Tuesday class will be on Wednesday.
