Ken Bailey Video Class — November 6th and 11th

Dr. Bailey continues his presentation of "Jesus Interprets His Own Cross" by discussing the Samaritan woman at the well whom Jesus asked for a drink of water, revealing Himself as the Messiah. Bailey then offers the great shepherd songs of Isaiah and the Gospel of John and, in particular, the images of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for the sheep. And lastly, the image of a woman giving birth is presented from both the Old and New Testaments as examples of the believer who is born of God in his relationship with Christ. Identical one-hour sessions will be held in Founders' Hall on Wednesday the 6th at 7pm and Monday the 11th at 2pm.
