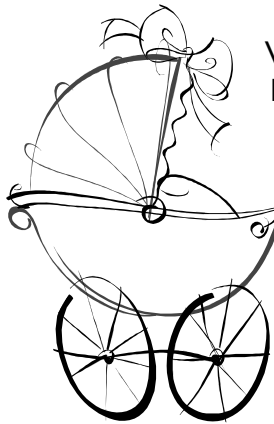


## Announcements
