Volunteers are also needed for the actual graffiti clean-up – volunteers will receive training and supplies, and then be assigned an area in Pacific Beach where they will clean up graffiti. Every year, volunteers at this event remove hundreds of graffiti tags and really make a positive difference in our community.
