Every year, volunteers at this event remove hundreds of graffiti tags and really make a positive difference in our community. Ken Bailey Video Series May 7th and 12th

The video series titled "Women in the New Testament" continues this month with a deeper look at "Mary, the Mother of Jesus." Dr. Bailey asks the question, "For what has the church praised Mary?" Is it for being the mother of Jesus or for being a woman of great faith and intelligence and courage? From the acceptance of the angel Gabriel's message through her hymn of praise, and Simeon's prophecy of "a sword will pass through your own soul," illustrates the courage and faithful obedience of Mary.
