Ken Bailey Video Series November 5th and 10th

In this series on "The Lord's Prayer," Dr. Kenneth Bailey continues using the Aramaic translation of the words found that Jesus used to teach the Disciples. Several paradoxes arise in this well-loved prayer: the Kingdom has already come but still in the future, the Kingdom is very near yet a long way off, and no one knows the time of the coming Kingdom but here are the signs to figure it out. The truth in the mind of our Lord is beyond us. We are also given some insight into our "bread without ceasing" (daily bread). It could be the bread we need for subsistence or the bread of the Holy Communion. One of the deepest fears of the human spirit is the lack of sufficient food. Jesus may be teaching us to pray for a release from that fear. The Lord's Prayer is a dense summary of the theology of God. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wed. the 5th at 7pm and Mon. the 10th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. We begin with a 30-minute video presentation, followed by informal sharing of our own understanding and questions.
