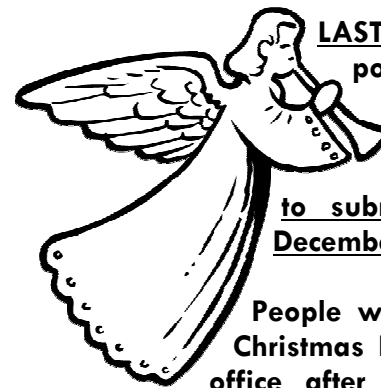
Planning Ahead
