Ken Bailey Video Class—February 9

In this second session of a 10-part series on "I Corinthians," Dr. Kenneth Bailey illustrates how the Apostle Paul has organized his letter into five essays, the first of which focuses on the Trinity. Paul shows how each person is a trinity: his or her body, thoughts and actions, and spirit. This is a parable of the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. And this is true because we are made in the image of God. A one-hour session will be held on Monday the 9th at 2:00pm in Founders' Hall. The session begins with a 30-minute DVD followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. Newcomers are always welcome to come and enjoy this series.
