


Planning Ahead

PUM GOLF TOURNAMENT - The ninth annual Golf4Good Tournament to benefit our Presbyterian Urban Ministries (PUM) will be held on Monday, September 28, 2015 at Admiral Baker Golf Course, 2400 Admiral Baker Road, San Diego, CA 92120. Green fees, cart fees, buffet lunch, soft drinks on the course, access to the driving range and range balls, live and silent auctions, and dinner after the tournament are all included in the registration fee of \$175 per golfer, \$150 if paid by August 31.
