### **Ken Bailey Video Class—June 3 and 8**

Dr. Bailey starts his discussion of the fourth essay found in Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, chapters 11 and 12. Paul begins with the subject of "Men and Women in the Church," where he addresses leadership and disorder in the church which included drunkenness at Holy Communion. Both men and women were sharing equally in the leadership and preaching of the early church. This was not a problem; how they were dressed was. Paul then turns to the problem of disorder in worship. Holy Communion was a full meal and worshippers were getting drunk. These people were profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 3rd at 7pm and Monday the 8th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. Each session begins with a 30-minute DVD presentation followed by a discussion of Dr. Bailey's insights. All are welcome.
