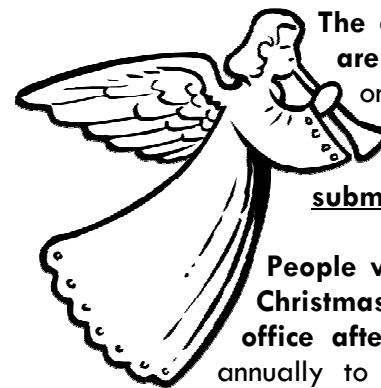

Ken Bailey Video Class December 2 and 14

This month we conclude this series on the Beatitudes in which Dr. Kenneth Bailey discusses the last six of the nine that are found in Matthew: hunger and thirst for righteousness, merciful, pure in heart, peacemakers, and persecuted for righteousness. What are the practical implications of these bold statements made by Jesus? Dr. Bailey puts a very meaningful slant on these familiar verses. His perspective on these and many other questions is very enlightening and encouraging to our walk with the Lord.

Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 2nd at 7:00 p.m. and Monday the 14th at 2:00 p.m. in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by a discussion of these beatitudes and Dr. Bailey's insights. Everyone is invited to come and enjoy this series.
