

### Bailey Video Class - March 9th and 14th

Dr. Kenneth Bailey continues this six-part video series on "Jesus Interprets His Own Person" by comparing Psalm 23 with Luke 15 as he looks at the person of Jesus and who He presents Himself to be. Jesus reveals His identity in the way He selects scriptures from the Old Testament and interprets them with Himself at the center. Jesus took the 23rd Psalm, used it as a model, and out of it He created the stories found in Luke, chapter 15. These include the shepherd and the lost sheep, the lost coin, and the prodigal son. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 9th at 7pm and Monday the 14th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. This 30-minute DVD is followed by a discussion of our reactions to Dr. Bailey's insights. This series provides a wealth of images about our Lord that can help the person of Jesus to become much more alive to you. Everyone is most welcome.
