We would like to let everyone know about the contents of the offering envelope boxes. In addition to the weekly white tithe envelope, each box contains:

Ken Bailey Video Class - January 11th

Dr. Bailey begins this six-part series on "Jesus Interprets His Own Person" by asking why we should believe the Gospels are authentic recordings of Jesus' words and deeds. He seeks the answer by looking at the person of Jesus and who He presents Himself to be. The stories in the Gospels about the same event are different in details. Does this enhance or diminish the Gospels? Each writer had the right to give the story his own emphasis and we are the richer for these differences. Dr. Bailey concludes that we have the words and deeds of Jesus authentically recorded with an emphasis which enriches them. A one-hour session will be held on Mon. the 11th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. This series is an opportunity for us to see the person of Jesus more clearly.

The PB Women's Bible Study will be meeting Wednesday, January 13, at 10:00am in Calvin Hall. Pastor Alan continues his presentation on the basic teachings of our Christian faith.
