We would like to let everyone know about the contents of the offering envelope boxes. In addition to the weekly white tithe envelope, each box contains:

Ken Bailey Video Class February 3rd and 8th

Dr. Kenneth Bailey continues this six-part video series by discussing the way "Jesus Reveals Himself As Messiah." What does Jesus Himself say about who He is? The Messiah was expected to 1) become a political figure, drive the Romans out, and reestablish the kingdom of David, 2) cause a tremendous economic surge, and 3) demonstrate who He is by some great public miracle. It is interesting to note that these three items are exactly how Satan tempted Jesus in the wilderness. Jesus starts by asking His disciples who they think He is. He then turns to the tradition of the Jews, quotes Isaiah 61, reinterprets it, and in the process makes an affirmation about Himself. Dr. Bailey is not amazed that Jesus ended up on a cross, but is amazed that He was able to keep teaching this way for three years. Identical one-hour sessions will be held on Wednesday the 3rd at 7pm and Monday the 8th at 2pm in Founders' Hall. Everyone is most welcome.
