


Christmas Announcements

Ken Bailey Video Series—November 14th

Dr. Bailey concludes his discussion of I Corinthians 13 by continuing the list of positive attributes of love, including love "believes all" things that God tells us through prayer and the Scriptures. He points out that, for Paul, faith and obedience go hand in hand and they happen at the same time in our experience with God. Paul then concludes this "Hymn to Love" by revisiting its initial theme of love and the spiritual gifts. Prophecy, tongues, and knowledge are contrasted with faith, hope, and love. Prophecy and tongues will end when we are with God. Earthly knowledge is imperfect and will be replaced when the Perfect comes. Knowledge of God is knowledge of the person of Jesus who has come to us and revealed God to us. The one-hour session will be held on Tuesday, 11/14 at 12 noon in Founders' Hall. This 30-minute DVD followed by discussion will help us to see this great gift of God more clearly. Visitors are welcome.
