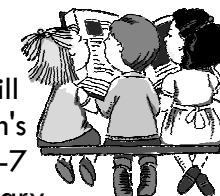

The irony is that the Jews had been waiting for the Messiah and God's banquet for centuries, but now chose not to accept the invitation. God the host then sends his servant Jesus to invite all peoples. Jesus assures us that His grace is to be believed and trusted. A 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 17th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall. Come and enjoy this look at this parable from an enlightening Middle Eastern perspective.
