Ken Bailey Video Series—Tuesday, June 12th

This month Dr. Bailey discusses the parable of "The Rich Fool," found in the 12th chapter of Luke. In this parable, one brother asks Jesus to tell his older brother to divide the family inheritance with him. He is asking for justice in the division of the family property. Jesus, while not indifferent to justice, refuses to be the judge over this request. Rather, He turns the subject to covetousness. The man is called upon to realize that all the property that we currently own, even our very soul, belongs to God and we are but caretakers of it. Not only are our goods on loan, but our very soul is on loan and we are responsible as stewards before God to care for both. Jesus closes by saying that a person who lays up treasures for himself is not enriching himself toward God. This 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 12th at 12:00 noon in Founders' Hall. Come and enjoy this look at Jesus' parable from a Middle Eastern perspective.
