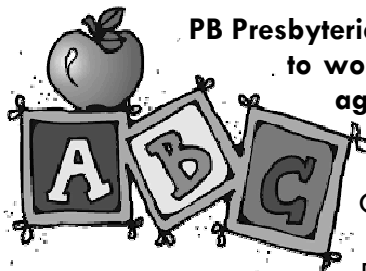


Announcements

Please Welcome Guest Pastor, Rev. Dr. Larry Grounds!

Rev. Dr. Larry Grounds served as the senior pastor of PB Presbyterian Church from January 1985 through the early summer of 2000. He left the church so that he could support his wife, Dr. Claudia Grauf-Grounds, as she accepted an invitation to chair the Marriage and Family Graduate Department at Seattle Pacific University. During those 17 years in Seattle, Larry finished his doctoral dissertation at San Francisco Theological Seminary about "How to design and present children's stories in Worship." In Seattle, Larry served in numerous churches (two permanent called positions and four temporary supply positions). His last pastoral call at Redmond Presbyterian Church was for 12 years until he chose to retire on January 31, 2017 in order to move back "home." (Claudia, although not retired, left her 17 year position at the University in order to support Larry in the move.)

Larry and Claudia cherish their years sharing in ministry with the wonderful congregation at Pacific Beach. They raised their three children-- Jessica now in Washington DC with husband and daughter, Karis in Clairemont with husband, and Micah in Seattle. During the children's early childhood years all 3 were blessed to attend PB Presbyterian Preschool and to go through the church's Sunday School and Youth programs. **After today's worship Larry and Claudia open their home to you for snacks and beverages.** (This is the same home in University City they owned when serving in the Pacific Beach Church.)
