

Ken Bailey Video Series—Tuesday, November 13th

This month Dr. Bailey discusses four parables found in the gospel according to Luke. The first one is called "The Three Eager Disciples" which is about different men whom Jesus asked to follow Him, two of whom gave excuses of family responsibilities that took precedence over Jesus' call. The other three parables are about persistence in prayer. They include "The Friend at Midnight," "A Father's Gifts to His Sons," and "The Unjust Judge." Dr. Bailey reminds us that it is proper to persist in prayer only when there has been no answer. When an answer is received, whether it is "yes" or "no," we should respond with "Thy will be done." This one-hour session will be held on Tuesday the 13th at noon in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by a helpful discussion of the parables and Dr. Bailey's insights. Everyone is invited to come and enjoy this enlightening series.
