Ken Bailey Video Series This Tuesday, October 9th

This month Dr. Bailey shares his insights about "The Unjust Steward" and "God, the Truth, and Mammon." The steward was about to lose his job and devised a plan that would cause the master's debtors to think kindly of him and take him into their homes when he was fired. The master chose to pay the price of the clever steward's action, thus giving us an example of God paying the price of our salvation. The second passage is about the use of our money. All the money we think we own really belongs to God. Therefore we are stewards of it. If we are not honest and responsible in its use, then God cannot trust us with knowledge of Himself. **A one-hour session will be held on Tuesday the 9th at 12:00 noon.** The 30-minute DVD is followed by an informal discussion of the parables and Dr. Bailey's insights. Everyone is invited to come and enjoy this insightful series.
