**Change to Youth Donations:** Beginning February we will be changing the donation spot called Youth Campership to Youth Activities. This allows the youth to use it for camperships or any other Youth Activities. All previous donations to Youth Camperships will remain in dedicated funds and used only for Youth Campership. We appreciate all the help you provide our youth in your thoughtful donations, we just need a little more flexibility with those donations moving forward. Thank you.

**We would like to let everyone know about the contents of the offering envelope boxes. In addition to the weekly white tithe envelope, each box contains:**

- Initial Offering Envelope (yellow) is a contribution to the printing and processing of offering envelopes. It helps the church offset this cost. You can contribute any amount.
- Per Capita Apportionment (blue) is the amount of money per member of the church that we send to the Presbytery to use in their mission work. *It is \$37.16 per person for 2019.*
- Milestones (pink) is a donation to our endowment program. The endowment is an investment account for the church to assist in our financial needs. You may contribute any amount and it will go into our investment portfolio. This portfolio is professionally managed and the amounts invested remain secure.
- Deacons' Fund (white and gold) is a monthly envelope that designates funds to the Deacons of the church to use in their mission work here in PB and San Diego. You may donate any amount.

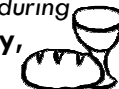
## Adult Education

### **Ken Bailey Video Series on February 5th**

Dr. Bailey continues this month with the parables of "Pilate, the Galileans and the Tower" and "The Barren Fig Tree." Pilate sent his troops into the Temple and the inner sanctuary where the priest who was offering the Atonement sacrifice was killed. Jesus used this event to illustrate that there is no 1-to-1 relationship between sin and suffering. God's judgment is not something He does because He is angry, but rather is something we bring upon ourselves. In "The Barren Fig Tree," Jesus is talking about unfruitful leadership. The spiritual leadership must produce fruit. If they fail, they are wasting the energy of God's people. God cares for His community and will turn away its leadership so that others can take its place. This one-hour session will be held on Tuesday the 5th at noon in Founders' Hall. The 30-minute DVD is followed by a discussion of these parables and Dr. Bailey's insights. If you have not attended before, you can come to this or any monthly presentation. Each one is a lesson in itself. Come and enjoy.
