

Ken Bailey Video Series—March 12th

This month Dr. Bailey concludes his study of Jesus' parables with "The Farmer and His Servant" and "The Widow and the Judge." In the first parable, the servant who has been working in the field is expected to serve the noon meal to his master before serving himself. We are to serve our Master out of our loyalty and love for Him and not for a reward that we hope to get at the end of the day. In the second parable, a widow persists with the judge until her request is answered. Similarly, our persistence in prayer is only appropriate up to the point where God answers, whether we like the answer or not. A 30-minute DVD, followed by discussion, will be held on Tuesday the 12th at noon in Founders' Hall. Come and enjoy this look at Jesus' parables from a Middle Eastern perspective.
